**SCHOOL BOARD STANDING COMMITTEES**

The School Board shall authorize the establishment of only such standing committees from among its membership as it finds strictly necessary to study operations in specific areas and to make recommendations for School Board action. The following rules will govern the appointment and function of such committees.

- A. The committee shall be established through action of the School Board.
- B. The committee members shall be appointed by the School Board Chair and each committee shall elect its own Chair.
- C. The committee shall be provided with a list of its specific functions and duties.
- D. The committee may make recommendations for School Board action, but it may not act for the School Board.
- E. The School Board Chair and Superintendent shall be ex-officio members of all standing committees.
- F. All standing committees shall be dissolved at the end of the School Board's year—at an annual organizational meeting—unless they are specifically reappointed. They may be dissolved at any time by a vote of the School Board.

All standing committee meetings are open to the public except as provided in the Freedom of Access law.

Standing committees shall be composed of less than a majority of the membership of the School Board.
