**ALTERNATIVE CREDIT OPTIONS**

In addition to regular classroom-based instruction, students may earn credit toward a high school diploma through the following means:

A. Summer School

At the high school level, courses failed during the school year may be made up for credit at an approved summer school program.

B. Adult Education

Courses failed during the school year may be made up for credit at Mid-Maine Regional Adult Education Program.

Seniors who are unable to schedule a graduation requirement may be approved by the Principal and/or Director of Guidance to complete their required course through Mid-Maine Adult Education Program.

C. Other

With prior approval by the Principal and/or Guidance Director, a student may enroll in programs such as college courses, online courses, or other approved accredited study programs. These may be used as elective credits toward graduation. Credits earned in this way will not be counted in class rank or GPA.

Required Winslow High School courses (e.g., English, Math, Science, Social Studies) may not be fulfilled in this way unless waived by the Principal and/or Guidance Director.

Each course will count as one of the minimum required credits in a course load during a given semester.
